Introduction

“The Secret of your success is determined by your daily agenda.”

This was the motivating factor enabled the Pragati Social Service Society to launch the vocational training program for the marginalized living in the rural villages, migrant laborers and daily wage labourers those have been affected by second wave of Covid-19 pandemic. Their survival was under threat due to economic crises, unemployment and ailments. At this juncture PSSS has intervened in their life struggles to provide them with stitching training that in turn would support their financial constraints.



It is our achievement that from June 2021 to December 2021 we have trained almost 500 girls and women in 20 villages.

Inauguration of Vocational Training Program for the first batch.



Inauguration of vocational training program was held on 14-06-2021 at Pragati Social Service Society, Karnal, Haryana. The Chief Guest was District Development & Panchayat Officer of Karnal. In this program various invited guests, people and PSSS staff participated.

Inauguration of new tailoring centers.

PSSS has inaugurated new tailoring centers at different villages and of Karnal. Every center was given stitching machines for teaching the girls and women.



Regular classes for girls and women have been conducted at various centers. It was monitored by animators and program officer of PSSS.
